Students On Governing Boards

The Shelton School District Board of Directors recognizes the value of communicating with students and receiving their input and perspectives. To foster this relationship with students, the board will annually seat 3 student representatives as advisory and non-voting members of the board. Student representatives will be from the 3 Shelton School District high schools: Cedar High School, Shelton High School, and CHOICE High School.

Student representatives on the board are expected to attend all meetings. Student members will contribute to board discussion by providing student insight and perspective, serve as a liaison for the Associated Student Body and report to students about the work of the board and district activities. The student representatives will not attend executive sessions, make motions or hold board offices.
